- 1. **Expected Outcome:** To ensure there is a secured fence line to form part of a layered security to protect the functions of the Royal Virgin Islands Police Force (RVIPF) Marine Base and to ensure the highest levels of privacy during the reconstruction works following the damage during the hurricanes of 2017.
- 2. **Summary of Scope**: The scope of this project includes construction of internal and external fences and gates, and to provide drainage works.
- 3. Method of Procurement: National (Domestic) Competitive Bidding (NCB)
