- the recommendation of award in favour of Trojan Design and Development to provide design consultancy services for the re-development of the Elmore Stoutt High School at a cost of Ninetynine Thousand, Four Hundred and Eighty US Dollars (US\$99,480.00);
- the recommendation of award in favour of Floyd F. Stoutt for the post of Project Manager (Individual Consultant) for an initial period of one (1) year at a cost not exceeding Seventy-four Thousand, Two Hundred United States Dollars (US\$74,200.00);
- the recommendation of award in favour of the contractor Sand Wise Ltd for the demolition of slabs and debris clearance works at the Elmore Stoutt High School at a cost of One Hundred and Thirty-six Thousand and Seventy-nine US Dollars and Fifty Cents (US\$136,079.50);
- the recommendation of award in favour of Amandla Engineering for the supply and installation of solar facilities at the Enis Adams Primary School (grid tied, exporting) and the Francis Lettsome Primary School (grid tied, non-exporting) at a total cost of One Hundred and Thirty-three Thousand US Dollars (US\$133,000.00);
