#### Job Overview

Define output and outcome results for planning, monitoring and evaluating the delivery of projects, including assessing achievement of results and value for money.

#### **Responsibilities and Duties**

- 1. Design and maintain the RDA Performance, Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) Results, Value for Money, and Contractor Evaluation frameworks for the Agency to ensure accountability and transparency at all levels.
- 2. Maintain independence of the M&E function to ensure objective review of project progress.
- 3. Lead and track the implementation of the monitoring process.
- 4. Provide technical leadership to capture and communicate programme results, as well as ensure high-quality, timely, valid and verifiable data collection, analysis and reporting.
- 5. Lead on design and production of economic analysis to support project planning and delivery, including compiling and analysing economic data as inputs to programme and project planning.
- 6. Provide specialist analysis and input to the production of business cases and statements of requirements/project proposals in collaboration with Ministries.
- 7. Ensure a process of continual learning and adaptation resulting from political and economic analysis of various sectors across public and private sectors.
- 8. Provide support to Communication team in displaying achievements through mediums such as production of infographics and data demonstrations and visualisations.
- 9. Oversee preparation of monthly, quarterly and annual progress reports on the status of project implementation; and contribute to other RDA reports as required.
